Subject: Call for nominations for the Tenth official OPCW Biomedical Proficiency Test (PT) – regarding.

India is a signatory to the Chemical Weapons Convention (CWC). The Organization for the Prohibition of Chemical Weapons (OPCW), with headquarters at the Hague, The Netherlands is the implementing body of CWC. National Authority Chemical Weapons Convention (NACWC) functions as the main agency responsible for facilitating the participation of its stakeholder departments' laboratories or the laboratories that are interested and/or have expertise in the analysis of biomedical samples in various PT and other activities conducted by OPCW in the field of the Convention.

2. Please find enclosed herewith a copy of the Technical Secretariat (TS) Note vide no. S/2331/2024 dated 29th October, 2024, circulated by TS of the Organisation for the Prohibition of Chemical Weapons (OPCW), seeking nominations on the above mentioned Proficiency Test from interested laboratories.

In view of the above, it is requested to send nomination(s) in the requisite proforma (Annex of the TS note) for participation in the Tenth official OPCW Biomedical Proficiency Test at the earliest to National Authority Chemical Weapons Convention (NACWC) for onward transmission to OPCW. The last date for receiving duly filled nomination forms to NACWC is **15th January, 2025**.

NOTE BY THE DIRECTOR-GENERAL

CALL FOR NOMINATIONS FOR THE TENTH OFFICIAL OPCW BIOMEDICAL PROFICIENCY TEST

1. The Director-General wishes to inform States Parties of the schedule and arrangements for the Tenth Official OPCW Biomedical Proficiency Test.
2. For the Tenth Official OPCW Biomedical Proficiency Test, DGA Maîtrise NRBC, Département d'Analyse Chimique (France), will prepare the test samples, and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (United States of America) will assist in the evaluation of the results. The anticipated sample dispatch date is 28 February 2025, and the samples will be shipped to test participants from the sample preparation laboratory.
3. States Parties are invited to nominate laboratories that are interested and/or have expertise in the analysis of biomedical samples to participate in the test. Nominations should be sent to the OPCW Laboratory via email (biopt@opcw.org) **no later than 7 February 2025**.
4. Nominations should contain:
 - (a) the full name and address of the laboratory;
 - (b) the detailed sample delivery address (if different from the laboratory address);
 - (c) the name, telephone number, and email address of the laboratory contact person; and
 - (d) any other special requirements or information needed to ensure sample delivery.
5. The nomination form that is annexed to this document may be used for submitting the nominations.
6. In order to confirm participation in the Tenth Official OPCW Biomedical Proficiency Test, previous test participants must, where required, submit to the OPCW Laboratory **before 7 February 2025** their follow-up report stating the cause of the problem and the remedial actions they have taken as a result of their participation in the last biomedical proficiency test. Early submission of such reports is strongly encouraged.



7. For the Tenth Official OPCW Biomedical Proficiency Test, participating laboratories are requested to submit analysis reports within 15 calendar days of receiving the samples.
8. Participating laboratories are also requested to contact the OPCW Laboratory by email (biopt@opcw.org) before the sample dispatch date to confirm their contact details for the delivery of the test samples.
9. Finally, participating laboratories are requested to arrange internal customs clearance procedures for the samples in order to prevent any unnecessary delays in the sample delivery process.
10. The Tenth Official OPCW Biomedical Proficiency Test will be conducted in accordance with the following set of quality management system documents:
 - (a) “Standard Operating Procedure for the Organisation of OPCW Biomedical Proficiency Tests” (QDOC/LAB/SOP/BioPT01);
 - (b) “Work Instruction for the Preparation of Samples for OPCW Biomedical Proficiency Tests” (QDOC/LAB/WI/BioPT02);
 - (c) “Work Instruction for the Evaluation of the Results of OPCW Biomedical Proficiency Tests” (QDOC/LAB/WI/BioPT03); and
 - (d) “Work Instruction for the Reporting of the Results of the OPCW Biomedical Proficiency Tests” (QDOC/LAB/WI/BioPT04).
11. A meeting to discuss the preliminary results of the Tenth Official OPCW Biomedical Proficiency Test has been tentatively scheduled for 16 July 2025 at the OPCW Main Building in The Hague, the Netherlands.
