NOTE BY THE TECHNICAL SECRETARIAT

CALL FOR NOMINATIONS FOR THE REVIEW OF THE INDICATIVE GUIDELINES FOR KNOW YOUR CUSTOMER AND CUSTOMER DUE DILIGENCE IN THE CHEMICAL INDUSTRY AND FOR PARTICIPATION IN AN ONLINE REVIEW WORKSHOP

BACKGROUND

- The Technical Secretariat of the OPCW (the Secretariat) wishes to invite Member States to submit nominations for the review of the draft version of the "Indicative Guidelines for Know Your Customer and Customer Due Diligence in the Chemical Industry" (the KYC guidelines).
- 2. The draft of the KYC guidelines is an outcome of the OPCW Chemical Safety and Security Management Tools Development Programme, aimed at developing useful tools and guidelines to support Member States in chemical safety and security management. In the previous two phases of the Programme, the Secretariat released two guidelines: the "Indicative Guidelines for Chemical Safety and Security in Small and Medium-sized Enterprises to Foster the Peaceful Uses of Chemistry" in 2021, and "Indicative Guidelines for Safe and Secure Transport of Hazardous Chemicals by Road" in 2024.
- 3. In the current phase, the Secretariat continued to provide platforms for a group of experts to develop indicative guidelines on the topic of Know Your Customer (KYC) and customer due diligence in the chemical industry. In order to prepare the draft version of the KYC guidelines, a series of discussions and two expert group meetings were held. At the first meeting in Colombo, Sri Lanka, in 2024, the experts agreed upon the approach and core structure for the guidelines and developed the zero draft. At the second meeting in Nairobi, Kenya, in 2025, the content of the guidelines was optimised, its sequence was harmonised, and the overall goal, target audience, and reference documents were refined.
- 4. This call for nominations provides an opportunity for interested Member States to review, through their nominated experts, the draft version of the KYC guidelines, and to share their inputs and best practices in this field. The collected inputs will be reviewed and incorporated into an updated draft of the guidelines, as appropriate, for discussion during an online review workshop scheduled for 15 December 2025.

- Only applications endorsed by the National Authority or Permanent Representation of the candidate's country to the OCPW will be considered. Applications may be endorsed digitally in the Eventus system.
- 10. To be considered, during the online registration process candidates must upload a scan of the personal identification pages of their passport as well as an up-to-date curriculum vitae, which must indicate their practical and professional experience. Only selected candidates will be notified by the Secretariat.
- 11. Applications must be submitted to the Secretariat no later than Thursday, 20 November 2025. Additional information may be obtained from the International Cooperation Branch of the International Cooperation and Assistance Division of the Secretariat.
